## **Numbering System for Cobalt Developer Technical Notes**

This Technical Note describes the numbering system for technical notes. This is done to be consistent in naming the technical notes as files and mail file enclosures.

The model is DeveloperTechNoten-x-y.pdf, where

n is the technical note number and starts at 0.

x is the major revision number and starts at 0.

y is the minor revision number and starts at 0.

## **Note**

*n*, *x*, and *y* cannot be omitted.

A *major revision* obsoletes all previous versions of the technical note. It can include substantive new or changed information, may have been rewritten for clarity, or may have had obsolete material removed. Major revisions are made when the technology being described is changed or enhanced, or when the technical note itself undergoes substantial changes.

A *minor revision* makes small changes to a technical note, for example, correcting minor typographical errors, adding minor clarification. Minor revisions are made when the technology being described remains the same, but the technical note has been revised in some way to improve it.
